Activities Conducted

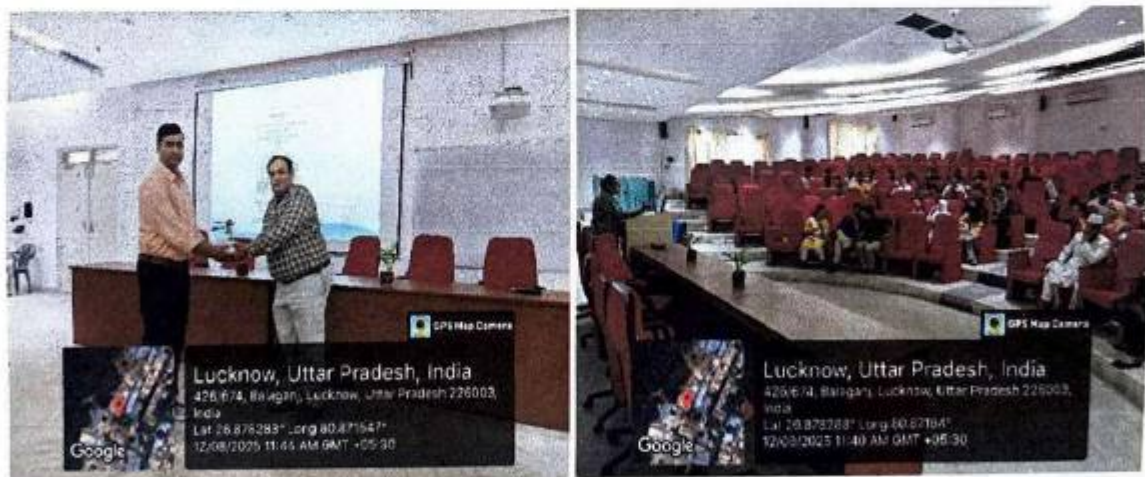
