One-Week International FDP in hybrid mode on "Navigating the Dynamics of Language and Literature through Research and Education"

24th February to 1st March, 2025

The Departments of English, Era University and Karamat Husain Muslim Girls PG College, successfully inaugurated the International Faculty Development Program (FDP) on the topic "Navigating the Dynamics of Language and Literature through Research and Education" on 24th February, 2025.

Dr. Naila A. Suhail, Organizing Secretary, delivered the welcome address. The keynote address was delivered by **Prof. Nishi Pandey**, Professor Emeritus, University of Lucknow, and Professor of Eminence, Department of English and Modern European Languages, University of Lucknow, enriched the audience (offline and online) on the nuances and complexities of both language and literary expression across various contexts and approaches.
