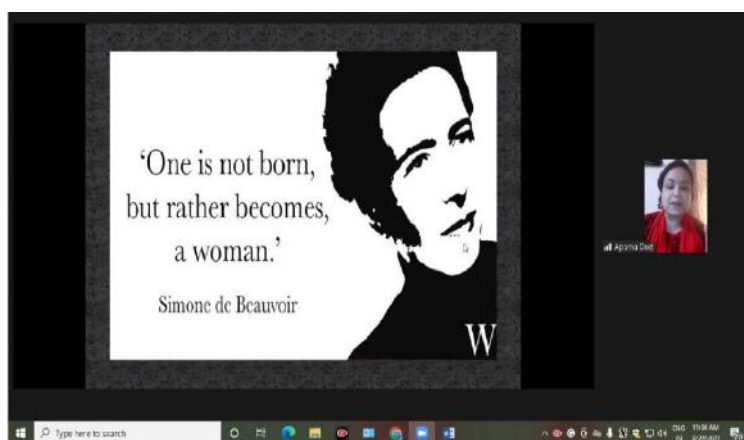


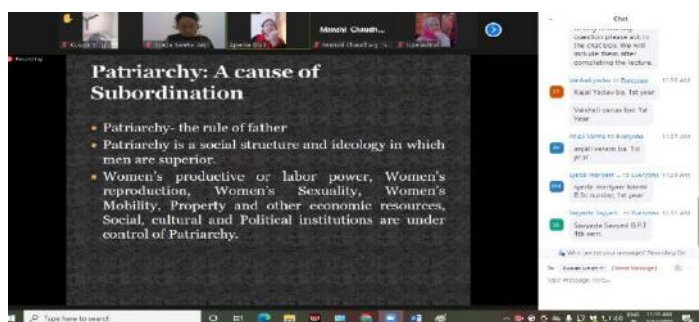

- *“Women’s productive and reproductive work is generally not assigned much economic value.... The invisible and unpaid work contribution by women, annually, is worth US \$ 11 trillion...
