

NEP SAARTHI Activity-March 2026

Language Quiz and Trivia

SAARTHI Activity March 2026 was organized from 21st March 2026 to 25th March 2026. During this week, the SAARTHIs organized the Calligraphy Competition, Poster Making Competition, Poetry Recitation Competition, Food Festival, and Fashion Show. The overall theme of these events was centered on celebrating India's cultural diversity, heritage, creativity, and holistic development in alignment with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020. The NEP SAARTHI events were organized to promote creativity, cultural awareness, and holistic development among students through various co-curricular activities as per the guidelines of March Activity-'Language Quiz & Trivia'. Multiple competitions and cultural programs were conducted, encouraging participation from different academic backgrounds.

The Calligraphy Competition focused on enhancing artistic handwriting and creative expression. Participants beautifully presented scripts in multiple languages, reflecting cultural richness and precision in writing. The theme of the competition was "Celebrating the Beauty of Culture." A total of 25 participants, including School (Classes 9–12) and UG/PG/Ph. D. students from multiple institutions took part in the event.
