

Report on SAARTHI Activity (April 2026)

Digital Literacy and Innovation

An awareness programme on “**Digital Literacy and Innovation**” was organized under the *Student Ambassador for Academic Reforms in Transforming Higher Education in India (SAARTHI)* initiative at Era University, Lucknow, on **16 April 2026**, from **12:00 PM to 1:00 PM**, at the **Mini Auditorium**, under the supervision of **Prof. (Dr.) Sheeba Rizvi**, NEP Coordinator, Era University, and **Mr. Mohd.
